Character Descriptions

- Annie** – 10-12yo – A street wise orphan who is eventually taken in by Oliver Warbucks.
Spunky, friendly, big-voiced
- Warbucks** – 40-55+yo – successful business man, rich,
- Grace Farrell** – 20-35yo – faithful secretary to Oliver Warbucks. Poised, sweet, gentle
- Miss Hannigan** – 30-45yo – The orphanage matron who hates children but is fond of liquor. Very disillusioned, bitter, cold
- Rooster** – 20-35 – Miss Hannigan’s no-good brother looking for a quick buck. A sleazy, slick con man
- Lily** – 20-30yo – Rooster’s girlfriend, who is also out for quick buck. She is considered to be a floozy and bimbo
- Bert Healy** – 30-45yo – The Ultimate radio personality. He helps Annie by Broadcasting about the search for her parents
- Roosevelt** – 40-60yo – The 32nd President of the United States. A democrat and a friend of Warbucks
- Orphans (6)** – 6-13 yo – The other girls in the orphanage with Annie. These girls are gritty, neglected and vulnerable, yet basically honest and potentially loveable
- Servants** – 20-50 – The servants at the Warbucks mansion. Includes Drake, Mrs. Pugh, Mrs. Greer, Cecille, and Annette
- Ensemble** – all ages – Boylan sisters, Cabinet members, Hooverville citizens

Many of the twenty supporting roles are non-singing – acting roles only
